- Reporting to National Coordinators on 2015 Nature WG achievements

- Exchange of information among ECRAN countries

2.7.2 Appropriate Assessments, training programme on nature priority topics

subtask A): 3 pilot AAs within the ECRAN region

Expected outputs:

- 3x field main Appropriate Assessment (V. Kostkan) (April – May)
- 3x subregional workshops on the main assessment (Art. 6(3) HabDir and provisions of Art. 6(4) HabDir (June, September, October)

2.7.2 Appropriate Assessments, training programme on nature priority topics

subtask A): 3 pilot AAs within the ECRAN region

optional study tour to the EU

Proposal:

- To remove this task from the work plan

Justification:

- AA is an administrative process lasting months and years
- Around 90 different AA approaches across the EU
- „best practice: is a synthesis of these 90 approaches

2.7.2 Appropriate Assessments, training programme on nature priority topics

subtask B): Regional training on the process of designation of potential N 2000 sites

- It took place in Podgorica, Montenegro in November 2014
- No follow-up envisaged
- Participants nevertheless requesting a practically-oriented follow up
- Possibility: utilize one of seminars under 2.7.3 for such a dedicated training

2.7.2 Appropriate Assessments, training programme on nature priority topics

subtask C): Assessment of readiness of ECRAN Beneficiaries for N 2000 designation (carried out by STE M. Hošek)

Expected outcomes:

- Consultation missions to each of the ECRAN countries (February – May 2015)
- Preparation and delivery of the first draft country assessments (2nd half of 2015)
- Second round of consultation missions (September – December 2015)
- Delivery of the pre-final draft of country assessment reports (December 2015)

2.7.3 Design and delivery of Regional Awareness Raising Programme

Expected outputs:

- Seminar 1: **Natura 2000 – from theory to practice** (May 2015)
- Seminar 2: **Protected areas in the 21st century** (June 2015/autumn 2015)

- Stakeholders' meeting (April 2015);

- Final consultation meeting (September – October 2015)

2.7.5 Regional Cooperation in Strengthening Capacities in Implementation of CITES

Aim: to build up on the current regional cooperation, involving a number of CITES stakeholders in ECRAN countries (scientific authorities, enforcement authorities etc.)

Expected outcomes:

two regional seminars (May – June, October – November)

Topics:

- general requirements under CITES and the EU wildlife trade regulations
- scientific requirements under these regulations and tasks of scientific authorities
- inspection by enforcement agencies
