Aim of the meeting:

Background

Since the local authorities/municipalities and other local stakeholders have an important role in SEA/EIA implementation, it is important to create a core group of the trainers in the ECRAN countries to ensure the knowledge transfer to the local level. The ToT scheme will invite 3 representatives from each beneficiary country and it shall result in the country-specific training package and SEA/EIA training strategies. Altogether three ToT events shall be organized during the project, while in between the ToT trainings the trainers should conduct trainings at the local level in their countries.

As agreed at the 1st Annual Meeting of the EA WG, the 1st ToT will be organized in September 2014. Planned trainings will be delivered in close coordination with TAIEX Unit that will be responsible for provision of non-key experts and organisation of logistics (training venue, accommodation and transport of registered participants, etc.).

This paper provides information on the overall ToT planning and agenda for the 1^{st} ToT.

Overall planning

The ToT scheme includes altogether three training sessions:

 1^{st} Training of Trainers (September 2014): This 4-day long introductory training session will focus mainly on developing the first drafts of the country specific SEA/EIA training material as well as on training techniques and skills and planning of the local SEA/EIA training events.

2nd Training of Trainers (tentatively September 2015 – the exact timing will depend on the progress with the local trainings – see below): 2-day long event will be used to review the experience gained through the local trainings and further enhance the training materials as well as to improve the training techniques and skills of the trainers.

3rd Training of Trainers (tentatively September 2016): This 2-day long final event will focus on finalizing the training materials and further planning of the SEA/EIA capacity building in the beneficiary countries.

Between the ToT events, the trainers involved are supposed to deliver the SEA/EIA trainings at the local level in their countries.

As discussed at the 1st Annual Meeting of the Environmental Assessments Working Group, the ToT will be organized jointly for SEA and EIA. This arrangement will enable to address linkages between these two tools as well as it reflects the fact that in many cases the same persons are dealing both with SEA and EIA.

Objectives of the training

The 1st ToT shall result in training materials to be further used in the local SEA/EIA trainings in the beneficiary countries. Therefore, the objectives of the 1st ToT can be defined as follows:

- Familiarize participants with the key principles of SEA/EIA to be promoted through the local trainings
- Develop the first drafts of the country specific training materials
- Introduce training techniques and tools
